Sub: Addendum to the Guidelines for Grant of Ex-gratia financial assistance to family of departmental officials/staff from the Customs and Central Excise Welfare Fund in case of death of official/staff due to pandemic such as Covid-19- reg.

Your kind attention is invited to the guidelines for "Grant of Ex-gratia financial assistance to family of departmental officials/staff from the Customs and Central Excise Welfare Fund in case of death of official/staff due to pandemic such as Covid-19" which were issued by this office vide F.No.712/19/HRD/WF-II/12 dated 21.08.2020. Subsequently, OM for the guidelines was further issued by this office vide F.No.712/19/HRD/WF-II/12 dated 14.12.2020. Whereas following criteria/ condition was set for granting financial assistance to the dependents of deceased officer/staff:

"It is hereby brought to notice that an MCCD (Medical Certificate of Cause of Death) as prescribed by the Registration of Birth & Death Act, 1969 duly singed/ certified by authorised medical attendant/ practitioner may preferably be submitted along with the applications seeking COVID-19 ex-gratia assistance. In accordance with the existing ICMR guidelines, only those cases where cause of death is stated as COVID-19 in Part-I of the said MCCD, will be eligible for consideration of COVID-19 ex-gratia assistance. In case the MCCD in the said format is not available, the medical/ death certificate issued by the Hospital should state that COVID-19 in one of the immediate/ antecedent/primary/underlying causes of the death."

2. The above said guidelines dealt only with cases of death due to COVID-19. However this office received several proposals whereby reason of death was mentioned as Post-COVID complications. As existing guidelines dealt only with cases of death due to COVID-19 and not to deaths due to Post-COVID complications, a proposal was forwarded to Governing Body to also include case of death due to Post-COVID complications for sanction of Rs. 5 lacs or 7

lacs as applicable for COVID-19 related deaths.

 Now, the Governing Body after examining the proposal has incorporated the following changes in the guidelines:

"Ex-gratia of Rs.7.00 lakh may be provided when the death of an official occurred from post Covid-19 complications within one month (30 days) from the date the staff has been discharged from hospital after recovery from COVID-19 and in case of home quarantine one month (30 days) from the date on which the official tested negative. This may further be subject to ICMR guidelines governing death due to post covid-19 complications if any in force at the time of death."

Accordingly, all new proposals pertaining to Post-Covid deaths may be sent to this
Directorate according to the amended/ added clause. All the pending proposals pertaining to
Post-Covid deaths will also be processed in the light of the above said guidelines.
