Inspectors from Kochi Commissionerate & CCO who have not attended/cleared the examination for confirmation of Inspectors earlier may submit their written willingness to this Office latest by **23.08.2023.** As per sub-rule 1(b) of Rule 7 of the Departmental Examination (Central Excise and Customs) Rules, 2008, a Ministerial officer promoted to the executive grade shall, if he has already passed the examination specified for the ministerial grade, pass the departmental examination in Paper-IV Law within the year of his

promotion to the executive grade. Such candidates may also submit written willingness for the examination. The candidates are also requested to provide their @gov.in mail ID and mobile number. It is informed that no requests for appearing in the examination after the prescribed date will be entertained by this office.

3. CBIC vide letter F.No.A.34011/01/2019-Ad.III.A dated 10.05.2023 has granted **One Time Relaxation** (OTR) to all the candidates who are currently in Inspector post but exhausted all chances to clear paper IV (Law) and also those who were reverted from Inspector post earlier as they could not clear paper IV (Law), by providing opportunity to appear in Paper-IV (Law) of the Confirmation Examinations to be conducted in the NACIN's calendar year 2023-24. This OTR is a one-time exercise and cannot be taken as precedence.

4. Those candidates who have passed their Matriculation or an equivalent or higher examination with Hindi as one of the subject are exempted from taking examination in Hindi. Such candidates have to submit their relevant certificates (Xerox copy) for exemption. Candidates who do not submit their relevant certificates along with their willingness will not be exempted from Hindi Examination.
