As per the Departmental Examination (Central Tax, Central Excise, Customs and Narcotics) Rules, 2024, only those officers who have completed at least 50% of the qualifying service for promotion to any higher grade as prescribed in the relevant recruitment rules shall be eligible to appear in the departmental promotion examination, subject to the provisions of rule 8.

3. The officers from Kochi Commissionerate & CCO, who meet the eligibility criteria and willing to appear for the above examinations, may submit their written willingness to this office latest by **16.05.2026**. It is informed that no requests for appearing in the examination after the prescribed date will be entertained by this office.

4. Those candidates who have passed their Matriculation or an equivalent or higher examination with Hindi as one of the main subjects are exempted from taking examination in Hindi. Such candidates have to submit their request for exemption along with the relevant certificates (Xerox copy). Candidates who do not submit their relevant certificates along with their willingness will not be exempted from Hindi Examination.

5. The syllabus of the examination is enclosed as annexure to this letter. If any officer requires the Hindi version of the question paper he/she may specifically request for the same in his/her application.
